HYSTEOSALPINGOGRAM (HSG) INSTRUCTION SHEET

PURPOSE: The purpose of an HSG is to assure that the inside of the uterus (uterine cavity) is of normal size and shape and to determine if the fallopian tubes are open (patent) or closed (occluded).

PREPARATION: HSG testing is performed on cycle days 5-11 of a 28-day cycle. Cycle day 1 is considered the first full day of bleeding. The testing is done after you stop bleeding from your menstrual period but before you ovulate. If you do not have regular menses, please contact our office for further instructions. The timing is to avoid any possibility of pregnancy. There is a possibility of cramping during the procedure; therefore, you should take an over the counter non-steroidal, such as Aleve or Motrin, an hour prior to your appointment.

PROCEDURE: You will lie on an exam table with a speculum in place during the test. A thin tube is passed into the cervix and then dye is injected into the uterus. As the dye enters the uterus and fallopian tubes, an X-ray picture of your pelvis will be taken. The test usually takes 10-15 minutes.

SCHEDULING: CALL VIVERE-AUDUBON SURGERY CENTER AT (504) 267-2805 ON THE FIRST DAY OF YOUR PERIOD (DAY "1" IS FULL FLOW) OR THE NEXT BUSINESS DAY TO SCHEDULE YOUR TEST AND PROVIDE INSURANCE INFORMATION IF APPLICABLE.

Your HSG will be performed at Vivere-Audubon Surgery Center, 2701 Napoleon Avenue, next door to Audubon Fertility. You will need to arrive 15-30 minutes before your procedure. PLEASE INDICATE if you have had any ALLERGIC REACTIONS to IODINE, SHELLFISH or RADIOGRAPHIC MATERIAL. If you have had an allergic reaction to iodine or radiographic material, your procedure may need to be modified.
